Teaching- learning process in any education institution is a regular and integral part of the system. But, this year, in this new normal, teaching-learning has become an extraordinary one. When the pandemic outbreak started and when the government announced tentative closure of educational institutions, with all foresightedness the teachers started delivering lessons through Google Classroom and Edmodo.
