Research and Consultancy

This academic year, a total of 7 scholars have completed Ph.D. from KCG Research Centre. Currently 67 scholars are pursuing their doctoral research and there are 33 approved supervisors in the Research Center.

With regard to publications, our faculty have been publishing research papers in journals of repute and among them, this year, 236 papers are International Scopus indexed publications. H-index of the college is 30 with 6208 Scopus Citations We have received fund worth 1.06 crore from AICTE, DST-FIST, National Institute of Wind Energy, MSME etc. for carrying our research projects. A total of 6 Indian Patents, 4 International Design and 3 Indian Design application were granted this year.

Received a Consultancy Project from Smago Consulting for 1,05,000 INR, from ZRAE Global, Chennai for 50000 INR and Thouway Technologies (Through-IITM PALS RuTAg) for 50,000 INR.

Training and Placement

Training Cell provided an exclusive training program in Aptitude for first year students and an Aptitude Refresher Training and Technical Refresher Training for prefinal year students appeared for placements. Dream offer JAVA training and Technical Training were also provided. With the support of Alumni, technical mock interview was conducted for those appearing for interview with Data Patterns and KAAR Technologies. British Council Lingua Skills Examination was conducted after a weeklong training on language skills.

91% of our eligible students have been placed in reputed companies so far and the recruitment process is still in progress. A total of 108 companies visited our campus this year and among them Accenture, Cognizant, Hexaware, Infosys, Virtusa, Zoho, Capgemini (Aero), Kaar Technologies, CISCO, Data Patterns, Ashok Leyland, Minda Corporation, Anunta Tech, Avasoft, GX India, Sopra Steria, Maplelabs, Jman Group, Maventic and Brakes India to name a few are the leading recruiters this year. The average CTC is 4.4 LPA and the highest being 9LPA.

Events Organised

We believe in providing holistic education and focus on providing exposure to students through content beyond educational sessions, project competitions and technical and non-technical competitions. At the institutional level, Technical Symposium, Vivanta, was conducted on 12th September 2024 with 1000 registrations from students across colleges. The 2nd Edition of TEDxKCG

conducted on 16th March 2024 was a resounding success with a line-up of 17 speakers from various domains. Engenius 24, a talent carnival for school students was conducted on 3rd February 2024. A total of 1100 students from 20 schools participated in workshops and contests.

This year, our academic departments, Clubs, Student Chapters, Office of Student Affairs and International Services had organized nearly 170 educational sessions in the form of domain specific webinars, seminars, workshops and training programmes. Alumni are the backbone of any institution and the success of KCG Tech is in establishing and maintaining meaningful relationships with them. Their contribution through lectures and guidance are significant and appreciable. They bridge the gap between the curriculum and the current trends in the market enabling our students to upskill themselves. In addition, this year they have served as judges to most of the competitions organised in the college. They guided the current third year students on facing campus interviews through mock interviews. The alumni meet was conducted on 30th July 2023 with 200 alumni registrations. We value our relationship and we will continue keeping it strong and steadfast as they are one of our vital stakeholders in our progress.
