


MESSAGE FROM DIRECTOR

MOCK INTERVIEW BY KCG ALUMNI PANEL

In order to help students prepare for the placement interviews by software companies, it was decided to arrange one-on-one mock interviews by KCG college alumni for interested fourth year students. Fifty alumni from companies like Infosys, CTS, TCS, Wipro, Accenture, Zoho and others volunteered their time and energy for the mock interview. Facilitated by faculty, the mock interviews were conducted over two days, Saturday August 21st and Sunday 22nd.

The alumni asked questions based on the resumes forwarded to them in advance, patiently explained the errors, advised, and encouraged. Individual scores and remarks by the alumni interviewer were shared with respective departments. It was an invaluable experience for the 200 plus students that took part. "Great experience", "very helpful," "very useful", "got suggestions which were vital and will help us improve in future job interview", "learnt more strategies to crack the technical and HR round", to quote a few of the repeated comments.



CHALLENGES OF BEING AN ENTREPRENEUR

India has emerged as the second most sought after manufacturing destination across the world, and the global precision parts market is projected to observe a growth of CAGR 10% till FY2025 due to increase in demand for complex products. Alumni Ms. Shivananthitha, and Mr. Sorna Raj (Aero 2013 - 2017) founded SOSHER, a manufacturing unit established at the SIPCOT Aerospace

Park to bring improvements to the existing processes in the prevailing precision component market to deliver un match ed quality and delivery.

This is their story, as told by Ms Shivananthitha:

Growth:

Our journey stared at KCG College of Technology. After graduating as state level rank holders in the field of Aeronautical Engineering, with the support of our Aeronautical Department we had the privilege to reach our 1st milestone. We were selected as project Interns in 'E-Bird Technology (Drone) for Tiger Conservation Project' with the Government of India for the Development of UAS at the Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun under the



Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Climate Change in the year 2017. This was the result of our work done on flapping MAV while in college.

Founded in 2018, A.R.C.H. DRONES (Autonomous and Remotely Controlled Hybrid) aims at incorporating Drones in every industry to address their real time issues and help them solve it. As a result, we are proud to say we supplied drones, and oversaw its operations in M/s Srikalahasthi Pipes Limited (formerly known as Lanco), which deploy drones for the Safety of their Workers for the First Time in India. This also gave us an opportunity to exhibit at the Humanitarian Assistance and Disaster Relief (HADR) 2019 organized by the Indian Navy.

We started the ground works for our next milestone by applying for NEEDS (New Entrepreneur cum Enterprise Development Scheme) and I was the youngest candidate to be selected by the Task Force committee chaired by the Collector of Kancheepuram for funding and other benefits through the District Industries Centre. We signed a Memorandum of understanding with the Government of Tamil Nadu at the Global Investors Meet 2019 to establish a manufacturing unit at the SIPCOT Aerospace Park. We approached SIPCOT (State Industries Promotion Corporation of Tamil Nadu) and after multiple rounds of committee panel interviews, we

were the first one to register a parcel of land, 1.09 acre in the Chennai Aerospace Park in April 2019 and commenced construction activities. All the approvals related to the establishment and operation of a factory from all the departments such as the DTCP, DISH, TNFRC, TANGEDCO, TNPCB, BDO, DPH and MSME were acquired in a year and a half timeline in the midst of COVID-19 and achieved our 3rd milestone by starting our Commercial production in November 2020. With the grace of God, we celebrated our 1st year anniversary in November 2021 and our journey will continue.

Standing out:

One thing that we are clear about is that, we need to quote competitively as well as quickly. With our investment in technology, we can get the entire cycle time sheet for all the processes defined. And that helps us to quote effectively as well as conclude the work holding and tool requirements for the customer drawing. Then once the RFQ converts to an order, the real standout point in our process is our advanced software, machinery and trained professionals. Since most of our components are complex, prototype like and of batch quantity, we want to be very cautious of our resources. We are extremely concerned about unwanted rejections, machine accidents and tool breakages. With CAM software setup as the digital twin of our machines, we can see a 1:1 simulation of our machine tools virtually. It will help us virtually see and alter the work holdings, the tool setup and collisions, if any. Certain advanced features in our package help the most in cycle time reduction and 100% part conformance. Another important highlight which makes us stand out is the post-processor. It is developed specifically for our machines. Hence it helps in generating fail-proof codes to command our machines which reduce our machine idle time.

Support from my Alma Mater

It would be remiss of me if I don't mention the mentoring support we received from the Hindustan Group especially **Dr Anand Jacob Verghese**, Director & CEO, HGI. They have also helped us out with local police and other contacts. I am happy to say that students from KCG and HIET are interning with us.
