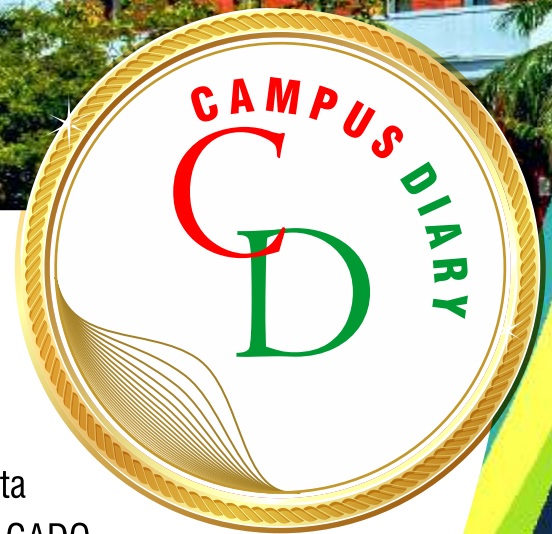
## EDITORS' NOTE
