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Shifting paths

Offering smart, scalable education for changing times

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South Indian institutions are stepping up to meet global challenges as the education scenario is changing rapidly. "India's educational ecosystem is now better equipped than ever to provide both academic excel lence and a safe, supportive experience for students, including international students," says Paul Dhinakaman, chancellor of Karunya University. He points out that in an era of global unpredictability, countries once seen as academic hotspots are facing fresh challenges. Students are starting to reconsider their choices. Many countries are tightening visa rules, suspending student exchange programmes, and limiting post study work options. Combined with rising tuition fees, these changes are making international education less accessible and less attractive for many! "Canada saw a 41 per cent drop in Indian students, the UK a 27 per cent fall, and the US recorded a 13 per cent decline," says Annie Jacob, director of KCG College of Technology. Geopolitical tensions and shifting immigration policies are further adding to the uncertainty.

THE OPPORTUNITY

By offering innovation-driven education and hands-on entrepreneurial experience, south Indian institutions are positioning themselves as world class destinations. These campuses are no longer just centres of learning they are becoming full-fledged innovation ecosystems. "Many institutions in south India let students build actual companies. Technology Business Incubators provide seed funding from '1 laik to '2.5 croves, mentorship from industry leaders, and access to angel investors. Students graduate with profitable businesses instead of debt," points out Jacob. Cost is another key advantage. While studying abroad can cost \$10,000 to \$13,000 a year just in accommodation, many Indian institutions deliver comparable quality at up to 80 per cent lower cost. Students benefit from government grants, access to venture capital, and the chance to earn revenue even during their course. They gain practical skills, technical training in emerging technologies, and exposure to real world entrepreneurship. Career-wise, they have access to strong industry networks, employment options, and business support infrastructure—including labs, legal aid, and professional workspaces. India loses \$ 60 billion worth of foreign exchange annually when our students seek education abroad. This is a national waste, By providing a comprehensive, updated, and liberated education policy targeting the aspiration Indian, it will be possible for the country to emerge as global education destination," says Chocko Valliappa, vice chairman, Sona Institutions and CEO and founder, Vee Technologies.
