

# IT companies delay onboarding process of hired engg graduates

Chennai: Top engineering colleges in Tamil Nadu are feeling the impact of the slow-down in the US and Europe as IT companies are delaying on-boarding of 2021-22 graduates with job offers.

Institutions including College of Engineering, Guindy, Madras Institute of Technology (MIT), Chromepet, SSN College of Engineering, and some deemed universities say 5% to 10% of their students who received offers from Wipro, Cognizant, Mindtree and others are still waiting to join them. However, placement officers say the IT majors have assured them offers will not be withdrawn and all students with will be recruited in the coming

ty's four campuses, 162 (8%) are yet to join. "IT majors have assured us they will onboard all students in the coming months. We have blacklisted a few smaller companies for withdrawing job offers," said Mala John, director, Centre for University-Industry Collaboration (CUIC), Anna University

# Games, coding & more: How engg colleges plan to welcome freshers

Chennai: From the basics of computing to heritage walks, pep talks by seniors, outdoor games and bridge courses, the first-year engineering students will have a busy first few weeks as colleges are planning several activities for the freshers as part of an induction programme this year.

Anna University is planning to allow the autonomous colleges to reopen for first-year students on or before October 15. University officials said the colleges with more than 80% admissions will be allowed to open the college after the second round of counselling is over.

Most colleges are planning to give orientations about the flexible curriculum and specialisations that were introduced by Anna University this year.

"We will arrange campus tours and talks by senior students for freshers. Based on the feedback, we are arranging Tamil classes during the orientation programme for students from Andhra Pradesh," said R M Kishore, vice-chairman of RMK EnThe orientation programmes are aimed at the smooth transition of students from school to colleges

gineering College.

The orientation programmes are aimed at the smooth transition of students from schools to colleges.

Abhay Meganathan, vice-chairman, Rajalakshmi Group of Institutions, said, the college will brush up basic concepts that are essential for engineering courses and teach coding during the orientation.

"There is a big gap between Class XII board exams and the starting of classes for first-year engineering students. Students tend to forget the basics in Class XII that are essential to understand the engineering lessons. We also teach them coding before jumping into the full-time engineering syllabus," he said.

Many colleges also started online activities for students who have already joined the colleges and facili-

tated interaction with the faculty members. "With the delayed start, they should know what to expect when the semester starts," he add-

Some city colleges are planning to conduct heritage walks to students coming from outside the state and other cities in Tamil Nadu.

"We are planning to arrange heritage walks for students from other states to the places like George Town in Chennai and Mamallapuram to give them a flavour of Chennai and Tamil Nadu's history," said P Deiva Sundari, principal of KCG College of Technology.

# IT companies delaying onboarding to March 2023: Industry experts

sually, engineering graduates join the companies before October or November. IT companies are now delaying the onboarding to March 2023, say industry experts

"In our previous batch, around 10% of students are yet to join. IT companies said they will onboard them in the coming months," said P Deiva Sundari, principal of KCG College of Technology.

Colleges in tier-2 and tier-3 cities too have many students with offers waiting to join. "Our students received 620 offers. Of them 46 students are vet to join. Students with multiple offers have joined other companies in case of delay in onboarding," said D Valavan, principal of Saranathan College of Engineering in Trichy.

Some deemed universities also said there was a delay in onboarding for a few students. "However, there is no alarming trend of delayed onboarding or withdrawal of offers," said Sastra vice-chancellor S Vaidhvasubramaniam said. Of 2,400 students with offers, only 40 to 50 are waiting to get onboard, he added.

'With projects getting delayed even the students who joined before June are not getting deployed. So, we are onboarding students in a staggered manner," said an IT industry expert.
