





### UGC's e-Samadhan portal to address queries within a short deadline

Students will get help in issues related to withdrawing of admissions post CUET UG results

o resolve grievances of all education stakeholders within a set deadline, UGC has launched a single platform e-Samadhan. The helpline, on its launch day, from 3 to 6:30 pm, received 131 calls, of which 119 were instantly answered. On the second day, between 10 am and 6 pm, incoming calls were 239. while 217 were answered.

Unattended queries were 12 on the first day and 22 on the second day. To minimise such instances, UGC will soon deploy extra staff.

Under this, UGC's official websites related to students' grievance, scholarship-fellowship, Covid -19 counselling, and Centralised Public Grievance Redress

and Monitoring System (CPGRAM) portal have been merged. The digital over-

haul will provide a 24x7 functional, single online window system for all stakeholders to register their complaints.

evances. Response time for anti-ragging helpline to reach out to students is ideally less than a minute, so it was not sensible to include this. Another reason for its exclusion is that many complaints are registered here, daily. So, it is possible that a genuine call could get missed, avoiding which is crucial."

Further, multiple types of queries will be segregated based on discipline and issues, and these will be resolved accordingly. To confirm 100% disposal of queries, UGC will keep an eye on the whole process."

Kumar adds, "Through a single platform, various complaints can be filed easily. Complaint status and progress can also be tracked due to proper documentation and unique docket numbers. The grievances will be reviewed by the bureau head and by the secretary/chairman on a weekly basis, for effective imp-
