

Report on Skill Development Training for Women in Karapakkam

With a small step taken towards making women self-employed, a 9 weeks Training programed where planned by the School of Fashion Technology for the rural women in and around Karappakam, Chennai under the CSR activity of KCG College of Technology. The program is sponsored by Y's Men International Club where all the trainees received a Sewing Kit and the fabric materials required for the training worth 2000 each. The trainees where allocated with the individual sewing machine and other sewing and pattern making tools are provided to them throughout the training program. A total of Nine Ladies attended the program, where they learnt about the various activity involved in the garment manufacturing process. The Skill development program is inaugurated on 18th February 2022 by Dr. Bhanurekha, HOD, School of Fashion Technology, KCG College of Technology.

Week 1:

A general instruction on the training program and the syllabus planned for the training were explained to the trainees. They all learnt the basics of measurement and the different ways and methods involved in taking the measurement. The trainees were allocated with the different sizes of dummy and given practice of taking measurement. We also asked them to take measurement among themselves and submit their own measurement.

**Week 2:**

Having their own measurement all the trainees are asked to come up with their own design for the construction of kids wear and Salwar kameez. The pattern for the kids wear, Salwar, kameez and basic blouse pattern were explained and all the trainees are asked to come up with their individual patterns.



Week 3

The selection of fabric material for the particular style of the garment has been thought in brief. The layout plan and the grain line details are also been explained in brief. Later all the trainees were been allocated with the individual sewing machine for practice.



Week 4

All the trainees were thought with the standard pattern for the development of face mask. Then they traced the pattern to the fabric and constructed a bilayer mask. Later they all thought with the construction of inskirt to their own measurements. They drafted the pattern and constructed the inskirt. Week 5

All the trainees were thought with the construction of kids wear with the measurement they have taken for their own kids. They were thought with different style of kid's frock such as A-line, Circular and Pleated frock. After the completion of kids wear they constructed a pillow cover for standard size. 


Week 6
