INAUGURATION OF BIOGAS PLANT

The Biogas Plant at KCG Tech, inaugurated by **Dr. Anand Jacob Verghese**, Chairman of the Hindustan Group of Institutions, stands as a testament to our commitment towards clean and renewable energy. This innovative facility, with its 15 cubic meter anaerobic digester, processes 100 kg of kitchen waste daily, producing 10-12 cubic meters of biogas, equivalent to 4-5 kg of LPG. By reducing pollution in water and soil and decreasing landfill usage, the plant contributes significantly to environmental protection and aligns with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). This pioneering project represents a significant leap towards a sustainable and environmentally conscious future, showcasing KCG Tech's unwavering commitment to sustainable practices and efforts to achieve a negative carbon footprint







KARGIL VIJAY DIWAS- WAR VICTORY MEMORIAL DAY



Kargil Vijay Diwas – War Victory Memorial Day on 26th July 1999, marks a victory day for our nation in the Kargil War through Operation Vijay, where the region of Kargil in Jammu and Kashmir was secured from enemy forces. The conflict resulted in the loss of over 527 Indian soldiers and more than 3,000 Pakistani soldiers, with many more casualties reported. To commemorate this victory, the Ys Service Club Karapakkam and the Y's Men Club of KCG Colege Youth organized a tribute to the war martyrs. This tribute included lighting candles, observing a one-minute silence, and holding an awareness event for the youth.
