A fleeting ghost beneath the sky.

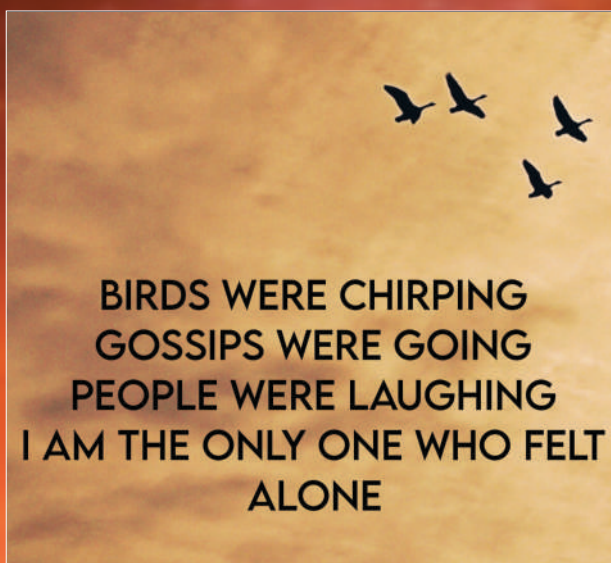
Betrayal struck at fourteen's gate,

Once lost in dark, she shines so bright.

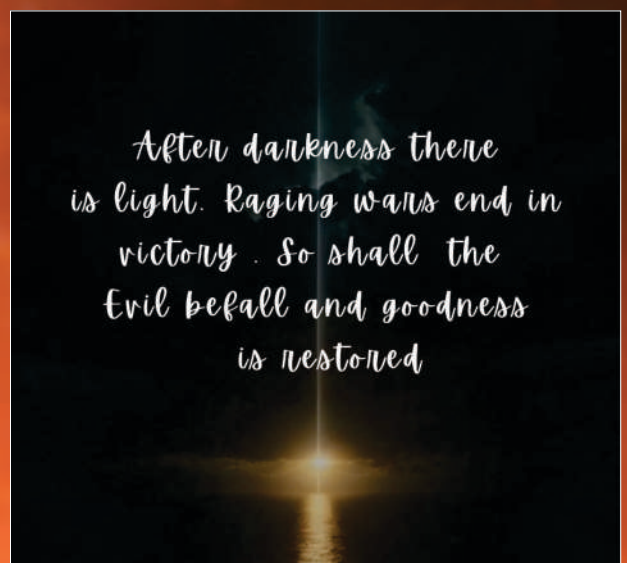
From whispers soft to voice so bold,

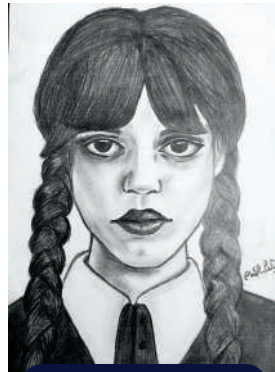

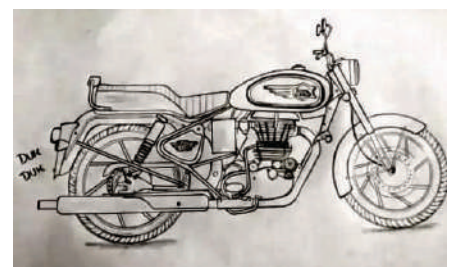
